Apgar reviewed risk and how risk was calculated, including the ranking methodology <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Includes quantitative and qualitative assessments. Some information is developed using the HAZUS program to project potential damages and impacts. ○ The hazard, exposure, vulnerability, adaptive capacity, and climate change were all factors used to calculate the preliminary ranking ○ The hazard ranking formula consisted of probability of occurrence, impacts (people, property and economy), adaptive capacity, and climate change ○ Assumptions needed to be made for some hazards (e.g. hazards where spatial data is limited) • H. Apgar noted that all risk rankings are preliminary and each jurisdiction needs to review the calculated rankings and edit as necessary, describing where edits are needed. • C.
